## Gasparilla International Film Festival 2013 Award Winners, Largest Festival Attendee Numbers Plus A-List Actors & Films

TAMPA, Fla. – March 26, 2013 – The Gasparilla International Film Festival (GIFF) concluded the 2013 season with more than 13,000+ attendees to the Festival this year.

"GIFF 2013 had a record-breaking number of attendees, a dynamic film line-up, talented filmmakers and industry professionals, plus we threw in a visit from an exceptional actor which was a big surprise for attendees," says Joseph (Joe) Restaino, board president of GIFF and programming director. "We couldn't have asked for a more wonderful way to celebrate film in our region and I am exceptionally proud of all the 2013 GIFF honorees and award winners!"

The "surprise" referred to by Restaino included actor, **Colin Farrell** who attended in support of Ante Novakovic, director of the film, *The Fix*. Also in attendance at the Festival were: **Thomas Jane** (The Punisher, Hung) who was GIFF's 2013 Career Achievement Award winner; **Gina Rodriguez** (Filly Brown); **Blake Berris** (Meth Head, Days of Our Lives) who was also GIFF's 2013 Rising Star Award recipient; **Ryan O'Nan** (The Iceman, Brooklyn Brothers Beat the Best); **Andre Holland** (1600 Penn, 42), **Michael Angarano** (Empire State, Haywire); producer **Randall Emmett** (Empire State, End of Watch) who was GIFF's Producer's Filmmaking Award recipient; and director **Dito Montiel** (Empire State, The Son of No One).
